Progressive Division Class Make-Up Policies

All progressive students can attend make-up classes if they miss one of their classes. As a rule of thumb, if you miss more than one class a month, you should make it up.

Progressive students should make up all classes in the level below them in most circumstances.

See below for the best make up options for each ballet level. For tap, jazz, modern and hip hop, please go to the level below. Look at the Season Schedule & Studio Assignments doc to see times, days and locations. (also on website)

You do not need to let us know ahead of time that you are attending a make up. Just let the teacher know at the beginning of the class and they will make a note of it in our roll books.

Ballet 1A:

1A students can make up in the additional 1A classes that they are not enrolled in. Please avoid making up on Wednesday because that is the day 1As work on their Nutcracker and recital pieces. (there are different casts)

Ballet 2A:

2A students can make up in any 1A class except the Wednesday ones.

Ballet 2/3B:

2/3B Students can make up in 2A or in any 1A class except the Wednesday ones.

Ballet 3A:

3A students can make up in any 2A or 2/3B class.

Ballet 4A:

Ballet 4A students can make up in any 3A or 4/5B class.

Ballet 4/5B:

Ballet 4/5B students can make up in a 3A or 4A class. (4th graders make up in 3A & 5th graders make up in 4A)

Ballet 5A:

Ballet 5A students can make up in a 4A or 4/5B class.

Ballet 6A:

Ballet 6A students can make up in a 5A or 6/7B class.

Ballet 6/7B:

Ballet 6/7B students can make up in a 5A or 6A class. (6th graders make up in 5A & 7th graders make up in 6A)

Ballet 7A:

Ballet 7A students can make up in any 6A, 6/7B or Ballet Tech class

Ballet Tech:

Ballet Tech students can make up in any 6/7B class. You can also see your teacher to see if a 6A or 7A make up class would be appropriate for you.
